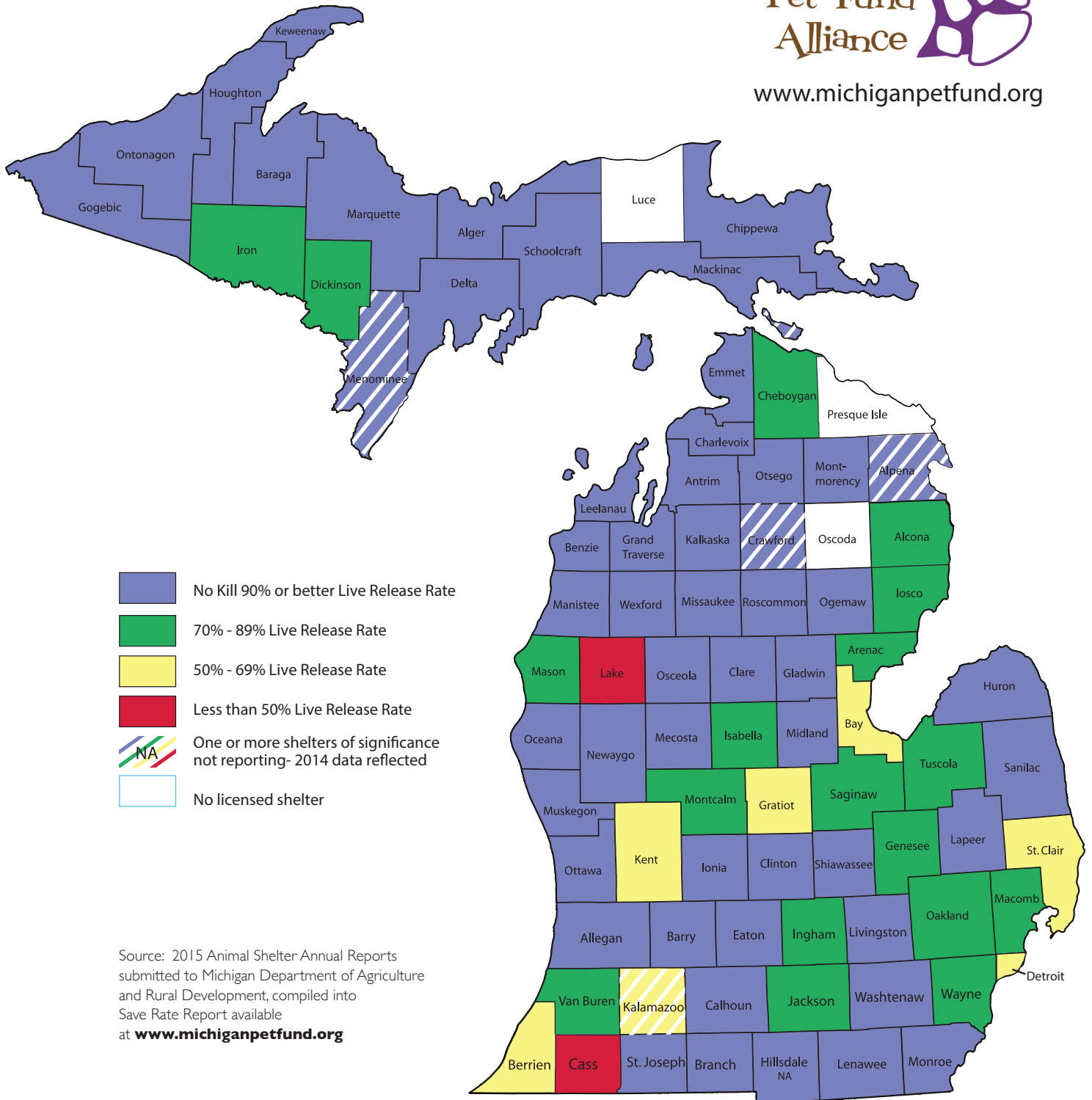

### NOTES:

First city/town listed is the county seat. Second location listed is to provide a reference to help the user locate the county.

Save Rates are determined by the Shelter Reports which are annually submitted by each shelter to the *Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development*. In counties where more than one shelter exists, all significant shelter report statistics were combined to determine a county save rate.

Michigan Humane Society does not provide their statistics by shelter (Detroit, Auburn Hills and Westland) but submits a combined report. To estimate the distribution for MHS the totals were divided by three and assigned 1/3 to Detroit, 1/3 to Wayne County and 1/3 to Oakland County.
